Registration closes May 20, 2019 (or when capacity is met; maximum 150)

Your registration will be confirmed, and any additional information will be sent by the first week of June.  
**Space is limited;** please register early. Capacity is based on sufficient adult help.

**DAY CAMP FEES:** \$75.00 Basic Registration Fee for registered Girl Scouts  
\$25.00 Program Aide Fee for (“PA”) trained teens  
\$10.00 Overnight Fee for girls 3<sup>rd</sup> grade and up to stay overnight Thursday.

Basic Registration Fee: is for all girls entering grades 1-12 who are attending camp as a “regular” camper. Fee includes bus transportation to and from camp, patch, all activities, daily snack, water bottles and holder, Friday lunch and a camp Tee Shirt.

Program Aide Fee: is for “PA” trained teens who are participating as a “PA” in camp. Fee includes bus transportation to and from camp, patch, all activities, daily snack, water bottles and holder and a camp Tee Shirt. If staying overnight, Thursday dinner, Friday breakfast and lunch is included.

**“PA’s” are required to attend camp training.**

Overnight Fee: is for girls entering 4<sup>th</sup> grade and up who are staying overnight.  
Friday June 28, 2019. Fee includes overnight outside camping experience, Overnight activities, Friday dinner, Saturday breakfast. Parents will be responsible to pick up their camper by 10am Saturday June 28<sup>th</sup>.

**REFUND POLICY:** NO refunds will be issued for day camp unless a request is made in writing two weeks before the start of the session. Please include camper’s name, service unit, dates of day camp, and the amount of the refund requested. Requests due to illness must be accompanied by a written statement from a doctor. A request for a refund, does not guarantee that a refund will be issued. No refunds will be given for an amount of \$20.00 or less. **BUS TRANSPORTATION:** There will be 2 pick-up locations: Comet Field (Corner of Wabank Rd and 741, Lancaster, PA), arrive at 7:45 am to load the bus and Price Elementary (615 Fairview Ave. Lancaster, PA) arrive at 8:00 am for bus loading. Bus will return at Price Elementary at approx. 4:15 pm and Comet Field at approx. 4:30 pm. **Please indicate on your registration form your desired pick-up location.**

\*\*For the safety of all of our campers, busses will be provided every morning and afternoon. We strongly encourage all campers to use bus transportation. If any camper needs to leave camp early, please provide in writing the date, time and name of person picking up camper. No camper will be allowed to leave camp without written permission from the parent or guardian and a current photo ID will be required.

### **VOLUNTEER & TEEN OPTIONS**

We need you! Day camp volunteers are the foundation of a great camping program for our daughters. ANY adults including **Fathers** and Girl Scout Teens are welcome to join our team.

**PROGRAM AIDES:** Are Girl Scout teens who have completed 7<sup>th</sup> grade and taken Program Aide training prior to camp. They may be assigned to units, to lead songs, games, or other activities, and help with crafts. Contact the day camp director if you qualify. Girls serving as program aides at day camp pay the all-inclusive program aide fee.

#### **ADULT**

**VOLUNTEERS:** The number of campers accepted for this day camp depends on the availability of adult volunteers. Both full and part-time positions are available. If you are unable to commit for the whole week, we have plenty of part-time positions. Indicate on your child's registration form how you can help at day camp. If you serve as a volunteer for 3 or more days at camp, you will receive a discounted rate for your daughter(s) to attend camp (please see registration form for fee breakdown). Please remember Adult Camp Volunteers must meet GSHPA requirements of volunteering, including: current GS Registration and up-to-date clearances.

**TRAINING:** All adult volunteers and program aides are required to participate in a training session. You will receive a packet of everything you will need to aide you in your volunteer position. The date and time of training will be determined closer to camp.
