Out of Council Registration Process

If you would like to join us for any of the college tours, you must first set up an account in our primary system.

You must be a registered Girl Scout, either with us or another council, in order to attend any GSEP camp or program. If you live outside of our 9 county footprint (Berks, Bucks, Carbon, Chester, Delaware, Lehigh, Montgomery, Northampton, and Philadelphia) you will need to complete the following steps using **19255** as your zip code.

Here's how to get started:

STEP 1: Create your records with GSEP

- Visit www.gsep.org and click Join at the top of the screen
- Click *Are you a new girl?* to start the process
- Enter required information using **19255** as your zip code
- You must use a different email address than what you use at your council. You must be able to access this email. If you do not have a second account, please create one with Google or another free email service for this purpose.
- In *Ways to Participate* section, click SEARCH, select Unsure and click NEXT
- When asked “Why are you unsure of troop/group you are selecting?” Enter **camp** or **program**
- In *Member Information*, enter required fields using **19255** as your zip code, select “parent” under Custodial Care and choose “School Not Found” under school
- For Leaders or parents who are creating records for more than one girl, Click ADD ANOTHER MEMBER on the *Registration Summary* page and continue the process until all of the camp/program registrants are listed
- If you need to register as a Girl Scout, proceed to the payment screen. Otherwise, log out of the website. The information should integrate to the Program/Event Registration system overnight

Step 2: The next day, create your online account and register

- Visit www.gsep.org and click Program/Event Registration at the top of the screen
- Click on NEW ONLINE ACCOUNT and enter the required fields for the parent/guardian. Remember to use the same information you entered in Step 1, including zip code **19255** and the email you used so the system can find you
- Click "Continue" and proceed to your email account to complete the activation process
- Once complete, log in and click the Activities tab to register for camps and programs

If, after the overnight integration period, you receive an error that you cannot be found, contact us at memberservices@gsep.org and put “out of council record not created” in the subject line. Please include the names and addresses of the records you created in Step 1. Since we have no other way to enter records into the Program/Event Registration system, we will need to determine why the records did not transfer to make necessary adjustments for the next overnight process. We will let you know when your records have been successfully created for you!
