



Girl Scouts in the Heart of PA

Summary: By Law Revisions Review and Recommendations

- Change all references in the bylaws of Service Units to Communities.
- Delegates would serve a one-year term that runs concurrently with the fiscal year. (October 1-September 30)
- Annual meeting attendance would be allowed to occur in person or via a webinar/conferencing format.
- The term for Board Development Committee members shall run concurrently with the fiscal year. (October 1-September 30)
- The Board Development Committee shall consist of 5-7 members.
- The responsibilities of the Board Development Committee shall be:
 - c. to provide to the membership in accordance with the time frame established by Girl Scouts of the United States of America a single slate of delegates and alternates to the National Council Session of Girl Scouts of the United States of America.
 - d. to develop in conjunction with the board of directors:
 - i. board orientation and education materials;
 - ii. board development materials;
 - iii. methods for identifying needed skills and talents for

the board of directors and committees

- iv. methods for board succession planning; and
- v. board self assessment process.

e. to plan board orientation and board development training sessions as needed and/or as directed by the board of directors

- The term for Board members shall run concurrently with the fiscal year. (October 1-Sept 30)
- Board Officers are not eligible to serve again as a member-at-large until after a lapse of one (1) year.
- Any person who is serving or will be serving as a member-at-large of the Board of Directors, shall be eligible to serve as an officer or as chair of the Board Development Committee within her / his elected term.
