### **Purpose**

The Long Range Property and Program Planning Committee's (LRPPPC) purpose is focused on effective use on Girl Scout in the Heart of Pennsylvania's (GSHPA) properties and financial responsibility to ensure the highest quality of Girl Scout programs for girls. Goals for the properties are to be determined by the committee to enable as many girls as possible can try new experiences and challenges, increase their confidence, and gain new skills to enhance their personal growth and leadership development.

The operation of properties should be as efficient as possible, with a funding strategy in place to meet the performance and property condition standards that our Girl Scouts deserve. Because location, setting, and facilities exert major influences on the quality and scope of the Girl Scout program, property considerations are essential to the effective delivery of Girl Scouting to our membership.

### **Specifically, the LRPPPC is tasked with:**

- Developing a property and program vision that promotes our mission through engaging and vital program delivery and excellent customer service.
- Researching and developing strategies and recommendations for presentation to the board that may involve property acquisition, development, renovation or sale in order to meet the needs and interests of existing and future girls.
- Develop cost-effective program delivery and property management recommendations that align with council program, financial and fund development goals.
