Team Building – Campers can practice working together through a variety of games, challenges, and puzzles! Instructions found at each team building element.

Trail Hiking - Get your campers out into the fresh air and explore the wild by hiking!

Boating – Canoe, Kayak or paddle board around the lake and enjoy learning boat control and build strength! (Seasonal activity)

- Age Requirement: None, but we recommend doing a swim test before swim periods or requiring life vests if no swim test is provided
- Rental Required Lifeguard, Small Craft Safety Instructor, or Canoe I Instructor required
