

Questions & Answers from Kick-Off

What is happening with GSUSA's new logo and the GSHPA logo? Are they the same?

In July GSUSA unrolled the updated Girl Scout brand, including a refreshed trefoil logo. GSHPA be using the new GSUSA logo with the name of our Council according to brand guidelines provided by GSUSA.

What do you mean by adding a fundraising element to the Gold Awards program?

We will seek corporate sponsorships for the annual Gold Award event.
