Treasure Houses



The Treasure House, chosen by the event coordinator or other persons in the service unit, is a home (or homes) in the neighborhood where girls will be selling cookies on a Cookie Walkabout day. The selected resident of the Treasure House is asked to participate by handing out a certificate to the first girl who comes to their door and asks them to buy Girl Scout cookies! The girl can turn in the certificate at the Cookie Walkabout Day Event to receive an award or prize from the Service Unit/troop that is conducting the event. The girls don't know where the Treasure Houses are located and it really brings some excitement to the Cookie Walkabout day event as they approach each home asking, "Is this the ONE?" Depending on the size of the service unit, several Treasure Houses can be selected in different neighborhoods. The homeowners also really enjoy participating in this part of the cookie event.

This event will encourage girls to visit houses in their neighborhoods to buy cookies hoping she just may be the first girl to find the Treasure House and win a prize! Try this as part of your Cookie Walkabout Day Event!
