JULIETTES

This year, Juliettes (independently registered Girl Scouts) will be managed by the SUCM for participation in the Cookie Program. Although we encourage Juliettes to join a troop, we understand there are reasons why a girl might wish to participate in Girl Scouts as a Juliette.

Once a Juliette makes the decision to sell as a Juliette, she must complete the sale through that method. Council will not allow a Juliette to change the method by which she participates during the sale.

Parents/Guardians of the Juliette will work directly with their SUCM, and must attend the SUCM's program training.

The SUCM will manage the aspects of the Juliette's sale, including:

- Collecting the Parent/Guardian permission form. This is the GSHPA Product Sales Program Participation (3-part) Permission form.
 - Distributing materials.
 - Giving access to help and monitor orders/incentives in eBudde.
 - Distributing products, incentives and patches.
 - Collecting Troop Program Packet and money and send to Council (including any parent uncollected forms, if applicable).
- Money collection will involve all money being turned in to the SUCM/Council. Juliettes DO NOT keep any part of the proceeds. Once full payment has been made to Council, their proceeds earned will be distributed back to them in the form of a Product Sales Dough card. The Product Sales Dough card may be used for GSHPA-sponsored camps, programs and/or at the Council shop in Harrisburg (and GSHPA online shop). Additional terms and conditions on Product Sales Dough cards will be sent with the card.
- Once the parent/guardian signs the Parent/Guardian permission form, the following should be distributed:
- ▷ A Troop Program Packet
 - ▷ Two order cards
 - ▷ One money envelope

Juliettes will follow the same calendar as troops. Juliettes still have the option to pick a time period to participate during the sale.
