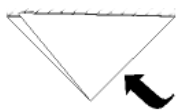


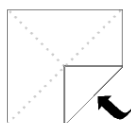

**Instructions:**

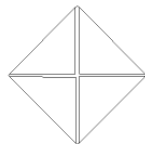
1. Cut out fortune teller square above.



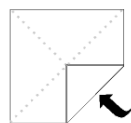
2. Fold it diagonally in half, then folder in half again so you have a triangle that looks like this.



3. Fold up all four corners so the points meet in the middle.



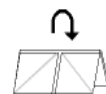
4. It should now look like this. Flip it over.



5. Fold up all four corners so the points meet in the middle again.



6. It should now look like this.



7. Now fold the top back.



8. Work your fingers into the four corners from the fold side - work the creases to form points.

## How to Play:

1. Start by placing your fingers in the tents.
2. Say "FOR-EV-ER GREEN" opening and closing the fortune teller with each syllable (4 times).
3. Ask another Girl Scout to pick a category.
4. Read the question from that category.
5. Let the other Girl Scout guess the answer.
6. Then unfold the flap to reveal the answer.
