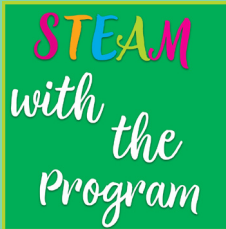

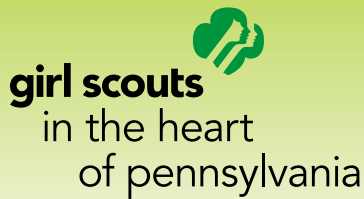

**Wilderness & Remote First Aid** - at Camp Small Valley March 28 - 29. American Red Cross Wilderness and Remote First Aid (WRFA) teaches advanced skills to be used in emergencies when help from professional first responders may be far away. This level of training is required when access to EMS is more than 30 minutes.

**Archery Level 1** - Completion of this level 1 instructor training allows an adult volunteer to lead girls in archery at any of the four GSHPA camp properties.

- May 15 at Camp Archbald
- April 25 at Camp Happy Valley

**Fire Building and Outdoor Cooking** - at Camp Furnace Hills April 18: This training is for volunteers who wish to introduce their Girl Scouts to outdoor cooking/fire building or for those planning a camping trip.

**Small Craft Safety Training at Camp Archbald June 5-6:** Small Craft Safety Training (SCST) is for adults who are interested in taking their girls boating (canoeing, kayaking, rowboating, SUPing) at Camp Archbald. This training will take place over two days and consists of both classroom and in-water components.
