Wildwood Park features boardwalks and trails amidst 229 acres of wetland, lake, woodland and meadow ecosystems. Situated between the Susquehanna River and Blue Mountain, Wildwood Park is home to a diversity of wildlife and is a Pennsylvania Important Bird Area.

The Olewine Nature Center is a gateway to this unique park with exhibits, classrooms, children exploration corners, and a bird viewing area.

The park and nature center are located in Harrisburg, one mile north of HACC and the Farm Show, along Industrial Road. Use the main entrance to the park and follow the drive to reach the nature center. Park in the lots by the center.

Badge/Award Programs:

Juniors: Geocache


**Saturday: May 1
