





GIRL SCOUTS



DIRECTIONS:

Stand


- 1. Customize each Girl Scout by coloring each one uniquely
- 2. Carefully cut around each Girl Scout/stand
- 3. Cut a slit on both gray lines on each stand
- 4. Cut out paper strip and place in between each slit
- 5. Adjust strip until Girl Scout balances on its own




CAMPING ACCESSORIES

DIRECTIONS: Carefully use scissors to cut out the pieces on dotted lines. Press and fold on solid gray lines.






NOTE: For the fire and trees, cut slit on dotted line and fit both pieces together.




NOTE: For the kayak, use scissors or a craft knife to cut a slit on the white dotted line - this is so your Girl Scout can fit! Next, fold the kayak in half so it stands on its own. Your Girl Scout can now go kayaking on the lake!

DIRECTIONS: Carefully use scissors to cut out the pieces on dotted lines. Press and fold on solid gray lines.






NOTE: For Cabin, use scissors or craft knife to cut on the dotted window lines so you can open the cabin windows






CABIN # 2



Cut – – – – Fold


NOTE: For the ball, glue half of each circle to the next. The circles together will form a ball.
