# Daisy Safety Award

- To earn this award, you will be practicing safety precautions and procedures.
- First, check or create a first aid kit at home. With an adult's help, make a list of things to replace or add.
- Practice knowing parent's names and an emergency phone number as well as your address.
- Make a list of events that are real emergencies
- Talk about what happens when you call 911

  - Make a collage or draw pictures that show your understanding of the Girl Scout Law (all 10 parts/petals)
  - Write a letter(s) or card(s) that explain the Girl Scout Promise and Law to someone else
  - Create a song or poem about the Girl Scout Promise and Law
