
Introduction

BzzZzzZzzzz! How did that bee get in here? Let's get ready to follow it and fly into the hive to learn all about bees!

- Let's Start!
 - o Think about bees. What are some things you know already?
 - o What are some ways bees help the planet?
 - > They help to pollenate our plants! The plants then grow and this is where we get some of our food from!
 - > They help the plants that our animals eat too!
 - They create honey!
 - o What is "The Waggle Dance"?
 - > It is a special dance that bees do to tell other bees where flowers that have nectar are!

Activity

- WAGGLE DANCE
 - o Watch the video included in the resource list. It is BUZZING with good information about bees!
 - Pay close attention to the "waggle dance" portion at the end!
 - o Once the video is over, we will print out/draw our own bees to use for our very own WAGGLE DANCE!
 - o Either print out this bee image (pg 2) and color it, or you can draw your own!
 - Once it is drawn and colored in, cut it out (if you are able to)!
 - o Now take your bee, and get ready to WAGGLE DANCE!
 - > To Waggle dance:
 - Stand in a wide open space. Maybe a living room, or in your back yard!
 - STEP 1: While holding your bee, take a look down. This is your starting point. We need to remember where we started.
 - STEP 2: Walk forward in a WIGGLY line! Go about ten feet.
 - STEP 3: Start to turn back in the direction you just started from, creating a LARGE CIRCLE, back to the starting point.
 - STEP 4: Once back in your starting point, walk forward again in that WIGGLY line!
 - STEP 5: Around ten feet, you will turn in the OPPOSITE way from STEP 3, creating a LARGE CIRCLE, back to the starting point.
 - You did it! Now turn on some fun music, and dance like a bee! The waggle dance!
