Below are introductory details in anticipation of the tree ordering form becoming available in January:

Our partner, Ten Million Trees pre-ordered 292,500 trees and are making them available for their partners to request. Trees are available on a first come first serve basis.

Tips/steps on how to submit an order will be available next week.

The tree order form is available via Ten Million Trees, from January $9 - 30^{th}$, by order of PA priority planting zones.

GSHPA is a partner with Ten Million Trees. When you fill out your order form, select Girl Scouts in the Heart of PA as the partner, and then provide your specific contact and tree planting location information.

Partners in priority 1 (Franklin, Adams, York, Lancaster, and Cumberland counties) are able to order the first week. In the second week, anyone in the Chesapeake Bay Watershed is able to order and the remaining weeks, all partners are welcome to order trees. Once the 292,500 trees are ordered, orders are closed.

Over 30 varieties of PA native trees will be available to order as bareroot, or seedlings. GSHPA recommends ordering seedlings as they don't have to be planted immediately upon receiving them. Tip: trees will be available in quantities of 25, and 36.

Trees are delivered to staging sites throughout PA. When you place your order in January, you will select your delivery location/date.

- March 28 trees delivered to Lancaster Farm and Home Center
- April 4 trees delivered to Shippensburg University
- April 6 trees delivered to Duncannon Warehouse
- April 11 trees delivered to Centre County Clearwater Conservancy
- April 25 Susquehanna County Conservation District
- May 2 Bradford County Conservation District

Tree shelters and tree stakes will be available for pickup at the Ten Million Trees Duncannon Warehouse.
