- The first of the quarterly Town Hall Property Webinars took place on Wednesday, June 27. Property updates and information will continue to be shared via the quarterly webinars with the next scheduled for Wednesday, September 26.
 Members' questions are to be submitted one week in advance to be answered on the webinar.
- The committee selected a company to conduct a Waste Water Feasibility Study at Camp Archbald.
- The committee reviewed a recent offer for the 50-acre parcel for sale at Camp Archbald and a motion was passed for the offer to move on to the Executive Committee of the Board of Directors.
- A recent conversation occurred with the Friends of Camp Louise to create more open communication and regular check-ins.
- Recent threats have warranted the presence of an armed guard securing Camp Golden Pond through the end of July. In situations like this, GSUSA and ACA recommend the use of private security firms.
- Camp Golden Pond closing ceremony scheduled for July 28, 2018.
- Camp Echo Trail remains closed.
- Camp Furnace Hills forestry management has begun and GSHPA has established a good working relationship with both West Cocalico and Clay Townships.
- Camp revenue actuals (as of May 31, 2018) compared against benchmarks, which were also shared in the recent town hall, were reviewed.
