Create a lasting piece of programming or an overnight experience while pursuing a Girl Scout Highest Award, service project, or Take Action Project at one of the four Girl Scouts in the Heart of Pennsylvania (GSHPA) camps.



**The list below is only a small sampling of the potential ideas
you could complete at one or all four of the GSHPA camp properties!**

- Create and operate an educational workshop for other Girl Scouts
- Organize an event to highlight an issue you would like to address
- Design and create a hammock camping village
- Create a geocaching or orienteering course
- Organize a tree planting
- Build or repair bridges for either general use, or handicap access
- Update lighting on a property to LED
- Create signage related to environmental or ecological topics
- Identify points of interest along a hiking trail with signage and a map
- Perform trail maintenance at a camp
- Create and design an activity kit
- Offer to paint/sand/stain a building or pavilion
- Coordinate spring flower planting at the entrance to a camp
- Create camp-specific scavenger hunts (Ex: riddles for finding buildings and finding out facts/history related to that camp)
- Design and build a slingshot course
