



2024 Money Management Tips *for Juliettes*

Being a Juliette is Girl Scouting custom-made for you! When participating in product programs, there is important information about money management to keep in mind:

Juliettes & Smart Cookies

Juliettes and their families use Smart Cookies to manage the cookie program. Because Juliette finances and proceeds differ from that of a traditional troop, the financial information reported in Smart Cookies applies only to troops. At the end of the program, GSHPA's finance team will update the family to reflect the amount owed by each Juliette.

Juliette Payments

Juliettes should collect payments for in-person orders at the time the product is delivered to the customer. Remember, Juliettes do not maintain bank accounts for any product program, so all money collected from sales must be turned into GSHPA by the Juliette payment deadline of April 19th, 2024.

- GSHPA's finance team will email Juliettes with their total amount due at the end of the program.
- Payments from online orders are automatically added to Smart Cookies and credited towards a Juliette's final payment.
- Juliette final payments can be made to Girl Scouts in the Heart of Pennsylvania via check or money order, or by phone using a credit or debit card.

Please keep in mind that because calculations for proceeds is done differently for Juliettes, Smart Cookies reports won't be accurate. Please look for correspondences from GSHPA with your Juliette's information.

How Proceeds Work

Once the program ends, the girls will start to receive their proceeds! Due to IRS regulations, proceeds are calculated differently for Juliettes, so GSHPA will send communications to families with this information after the program. Juliettes receive their proceeds in the form of GO! Dough or Girl Opportunity Dough. This can be used to help Juliettes fund their experience in Girl Scouts. GO!Dough can be used for all GSHPA events and activities, travel experiences, the online store, membership renewals, and more!
